Auction Rules

1. All bids must be in writing in the bid sheet for each item. Write your bid amount on the appropriate line on the bid sheet with your assigned bid number. You will be given your bid number when you arrive at the auction.
2. A minimum opening bid and an incremental price raise are indicated on the top of each sheet. Each bid must exceed the previous valid bid by the incremental price raise. Any bid that does NOT exceed the previous bid by the incremental price raise will be invalid.
3. You can not remove a bid once it is placed! Crossing out or erasing a bid will not remove it from our system.
4. All bids are final. No exchanges or refunds on auction items are permitted. Before making a bid, please note any restrictions or expirations that may affect the item. Unless otherwise noted, all items must be used within six months.
5. All auction items must be paid in full, either before or after the conclusion of the afternoon or at designated times the following week. We accept cash, checks, VISA and Mastercard.
6. Announcements will be made as tables begin to close.
7. Winners will be determined after the tables have closed. The bidding number with the highest value bid will be considered the purchaser. At such time, title to the item shall pass to the purchaser; the purchaser then assumes full risk and responsibility for the item.
8. At event staff discretion, if two or more parties are still bidding for an item at table closing, an on-the-spot auction will be held with minimum bids being 3 times the amount of the incremental price. Each participant will have 5 seconds to decide whether to match or not.
9. RPHS assumes no liability for any damages that result from the purchase or the use of any good or service offered at the Silent Auction.
10. The RHPS PTA reserves the right to modify the terms of this program, including establishing incremental bids and withdrawing items.

Important Tax Information:

The amount of your payment to the silent auction that is tax deductible for federal income tax purposes is limited to the excess of your successful bid over the fair market value of the merchandise purchased. The value of each item was provided by the donor and is printed in the catalogue. Retain the catalogue for your records.

AUCTION CLOSE OUT - BETTER THAN EVER

We know full well that there is no perfect way to close out an auction to make the transactions that occur at the end of the night happen quickly and smoothly. **But we are trying this year to the best of our ability to accomplish the smoothest, cleanest and fastest close out that we have ever had at Rosemary Hills - and we need your help to accomplish this goal.**

All bidders are going to be asked upon check-in to give credit card information to the Auction Committee. This will be the card that auction winnings will be charged to unless the winner wants to use cash or a check on the night of the auction. This credit card information will be taken down on paper and kept confidentially with the Committee members and disposed of promptly after confirmation of the charge is complete.

The Committee takes VISA and Mastercard only.

At the end of the auction, bidders can confirm with the Auction Committee what they have won. **Successful bidders are expected to take their winnings home with them at the end of the auction.** Actual credit card charges will be run on or shortly after Sunday, March 21st in an effort to minimize and eliminate the tedious wait time that takes place on traditional auction close outs.

Winning bidders who choose to pay by cash or check must do so on the night of the auction.
