Here's how you can get what you need on www.rhpspta.org

Thank you for your participation in PTA activities for the 2007-2008 school year. We encourage you to use the RHPS PTA website (www.rhpspta.org) to promote your projects or activities. However, we do want you to be aware that any content posted to the RHPS PTA website can be revealed via internet search engines such as Google, Yahoo, Ixquick and others. As a result, postings that contain your contact information (such as your name, phone number and/or e-mail address and your child's name) may be similarly uncovered during web searches. This also includes the board and volunteer lists posted to the website to facilitate communication among the RHPS community. If you have concerns about your privacy, please don't hesitate to contact the PTA co-presidents or webmaster@rhpspta.org.

Send the basic information in an email to webmaster@rhpspta.org. Include any attachments such as fliers or forms (preferably in PDF) and high resolution photos. (Note: information not in pdf will result in a delay in posting.) Also include any email addresses or other contact information. Typically, information will be updated on the Upcoming Activities or Special Notices pages or highlighted on the home page. Information will be posted as soon as possible, with the goal of posting within 48 hours of receipt of the information.

Help spread the word about the site by directing people to the site (www.rhpspta.org), especially if the site can provide more information than that contained in a flyer or email message.

Please note: The list-serv should be used for last minute changes or important information (event cancellation, etc.) We will do our best to get that information on the web site as well but the list-serv should be the official channel of notification.

History: The site was launched in the spring of 2006 as a way to increase the PTA's visibility and provide a source of up-to-date information for families at Rosemary Hills Primary School. This last summer (2007), Debbie Dine, a web designer and mother of former Rosemary Hills students, rebuilt the site. The site uses XHTML, CSS and XML handcoding programming language.
